## Exemption from visa requirements

If you are a holder of a valid residence title of another Schengen member country or a national of one of the following countries, you do not need a visa to enter and to reside in Austria for up to **90 days within 180 days**.

The prerequisite is that you

- do not wish to stay in Austria for longer than the period stated below and
- do not intend to take up gainful employment in Austria.

For those in possession of a service/official passport (*Dienstpass*) or a diplomatic passport separate regulations apply (information is available from the <u>Austrian representative</u> <u>authorities</u>). If you are allowed to enter Austria without a visa, you may apply for a residence title during your permitted visa-free stay in Austria. The application, however, does not permit you to stay for longer than your permitted visa-free stay.

<u>Please note:</u> The visa-free stay basically applies to the entire Schengen area, i.e. days that you spend in other Schengen countries count towards the 90 days of your visa free stay!
